Why Choose Your Primary Care Clinician on Medicare.gov?

Your primary care clinician can help you make health care decisions and can improve how you manage your health care.

Your primary care clinician is a health care clinician—a doctor, physician assistant, nurse practitioner, or certified nurse specialist—who is responsible for coordinating your overall care, no matter where you choose to get health care services.

The **Making Care Primary Model (MCP)** is a Medicare model that aims to improve the quality and value of the primary care you receive. When you choose a primary care clinician that participates in MCP, your clinician gets access to tools and services to better coordinate your care and improve your health.
